






Minsk founded more than 900 years ago. Minsk is the city where one can find the best of the Belarusian cultural heritage museums, exhibitions, theatres.

The Berezinsky Reserve is one of the oldest protected areas in Belarus. It is a real model of true wilderness and one of very few undisturbed corners of the southern European taiga. The Reserve is located 130 km north-east of Minsk on the edge of the watersheds between the Black and Baltic Sea in the vicinity of the river Berezina. Here is a land of virginal primeval forests, marsh plains and lakes, rich in diverse flora and fauna.



The PROGRAM:

- Visit to the Museum of Nature where the voiced exposition of flora and fauna of Belarus is presented;
- Visit to the open-air cages with wild animals;
- Lunch will be served in a restaurant of a former presidential residence by the picturesque banks of the Plavno lake.
